- The Israel Foreign Media Survey scours the internet (Sunday thru Thursday) for pertinent news articles and editorials affecting Israel appearing in the world's major English edition newspapers and web sites for the particular day(s) stated.
- The survey attempts to present only original source articles, occasionally resorting to reprints in special cases.
 - Stories by wire agencies and major newspapers (ex: AP, Reuters, NY Times etc.) often are licensed or sold to smaller market media agencies, and appear in the survey ONLY in their original
